


Strategic plan of internationalization












Dynamics of joint SNAU-HSWT master course participants







International accreditation of the study program





Joint international accreditation of the IMA master's course:

In September 2022, SNAU together with HSWT received international accreditation of the master's course "Administrative Management" for the next 7 years.

The purpose of international accreditation is to confirm the full compliance of the content and quality of the educational process at SNAU with European educational standards.

On January 20, 2023, the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine adopted a decision to expand the list of foreign accreditation agencies and higher education quality assurance agencies whose certificates on accreditation of educational programs are officially recognized in Ukraine.

ACQUIN agency (Germany) was also included in this list as a result of SNAU's application.


