 <p><b>Removal:</b> every four weeks*</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- clean paper</li> <li>- scraped clean paper packaging</li> <li>- cardboard</li> <li>- <b>clean</b> pizza cartons</li> <li>- books</li> <li>- newspaper, catalogues, brochures</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- dirty, soiled, or pasted paper (e.g. tissues, diapers, pads, dirty paper towels)</li> <li>- milk &amp; juice cartons</li> <li>- <b>thermal paper (bills/receipts)</b></li> <li>- envelopes/mailings with plastic embedding</li> <li>- foil coated paper</li> <li>- dirty pizza cartons</li> <li>- photo paper, wallpaper</li> <li>- parchment paper</li> <li>- Post-its</li> </ul>	 <p><b>Removal:</b> every 14 days*</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- organic kitchen waste (vegetables, fruit)</li> <li>- cooked food</li> <li>- meat and sausage leftovers (cooked!)</li> <li>- spoilt food (without packaging!)</li> <li>- paper towels covered in kitchen fat, sauces</li> <li>- eggshells</li> <li>- coffee filter</li> <li>- tea bags</li> <li>- bread and pastry leftovers</li> <li>- hair, feathers</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>raw</b> animal waste</li> <li>- grass clipping</li> <li>- foliage</li> <li>- ash, charcoal</li> <li>- residual waste</li> <li>- packaging/ plastic waste</li> <li>- diapers</li> <li>- animal feces</li> <li>- cigarette butts</li> <li>- vacuum cleaner bags</li> </ul>
