	Proof of good German language skills, via a language certificate at the DSH-2 level, a Goethe certificate level C2, a UNIcert® certificate for German level IV or equivalent (§ 9 Para. 3 of the Dissertation Regulations)  → The following applicants are exempt from this condition: a) those who have completed a master's program in law within Germany, and b) those for whom two members of the teaching staff declare themselves willing to supervise the doctoral project even when the dissertation and oral examination are conducted and written in a foreign language
