

An Electronic Edition of South Slavic Medieval Parchment Fragments
Andrej Bojadžiev (Sofia University)

The paper presents ideas, structures and preliminary results of an ongoing study at the Department of Cyrillic and Methodian Studies (Sofia University). The edition in the hard copy form is divided into several fragments which are linked together. The electronic version of the text itself is formed according to the TEI XML scheme (Text Encoding Initiative Consortium, <http://www.tei-c.org/>) together with paleographic, linguistic and text comments. The description of the manuscript is based on the model of another project – Repertorium of Old Bulgarian Literature and Letters (<http://repertorium.obdurodon.org/>). The third part of the edition is formed by the links to digital copies of the manuscript as they are present in National Academic Library and Information System (<http://www.nalis.bg/>). In the paper many issues are raised which need deeper consideration. Among them are the underlying format of linguistic data and their representation, link mechanisms, implementation of database and possible search opportunities.
